We have been developing a range of skills in the kitchen preparing our shared lunches. We

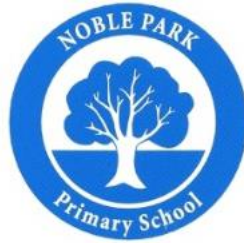

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FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

SCHOOL REVIEW YEAR

Schools undertake a school review every 4 years to inform the directions of the school's 4-year School Strategic Plan (SSP). This is a legislative requirement for all schools. The first component of the review is the pre-review self-evaluation (PRSE) where schools review their data and other evidence to form a collective view of current practice and areas for improvement.

Noble Park Primary School is currently working with staff to analyse multiple sets of data and reflect on the school's performance over the past 4 years, with a particular focus on identifying enablers and barriers to success. This work will continue in Term 2 and will be a focus for all staff on the curriculum day scheduled for Monday 24th April 2023. Following the curriculum day, parents/guardians will be invited to take part in small group discussions to provide feedback that will be included in the PRSE documentation.
