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Little Learners Love Literacy in the Junior Learning House

This semester, the students have engaged in explicit and sequential literacy teaching through the Little Learners Love Literacy Program. This program is systematic and engaging with focused explicit lessons, games, crafts, music, puppets and drawing. Decodable Books are the 'secret ingredient' for success. This is because they only use the sounds and letters children have been explicitly taught allowing them to apply their learning and build confidence.

Let's Spell helps the students to spell and create their own words, using the letters that they have learnt in previous lessons.

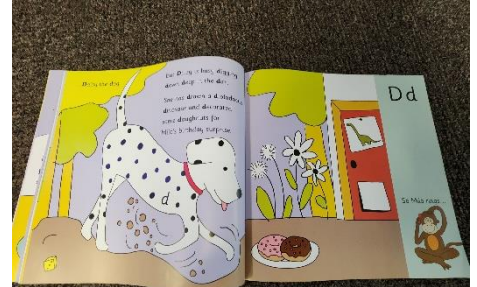
How can you help your child at home?

Read many and varied books to your child and talk about what you have read. Choosing a quiet time, such as bedtime, can help build an easy and fun reading routine.

Tip # 1: Encourage your child to ask questions about the book and the new words they encounter. This helps them to expand their vocabulary and develop their understanding.

Tip # 2: If your child comes across a word that they don't know, explain it to them and use it in a sentence to help them understand its meaning.

Tip # 3: Talk to your child about the pictures in the book and ask them what they notice.
