2024 Swimming Program

Today notices have been provided to students regarding the Swimming Program that will take place in Term 3. The program consists of eight sessions commencing on 29th July and concluding on 9th of August (excluding both Tuesdays). A 25% subsidy has been provided by the school so that the program is accessible to all students. Parents/Carers have the option to pay via BPay, Direct Deposit or Eftpos (at the office). The cost is \$65 and swimming caps are included in the cost. Parent Payment plans are also available by calling the front office and asking to speak to a member of our leadership team.



Reminder about student supervision

Noble Park Primary School's grounds are supervised by school staff from 8:30am until 3:45pm. Outside of these hours, school staff will not be available to supervise students. Before school the front gate (Buckley Street) will be opened at 8:30am. Students are to remain in the area next to the kitchen or on the basketball court which is in front of the breakfast club/kitchen between 8:30am and 8:45am. The back gate (Leonard Avenue) will be opened at 8:45am and students are permitted to play on the back basketball courts. The oval and play equipment are out of bounds before 9:00am. Teachers on yard duty will supervise between 8:45am and 9:00am.



Upcoming Respectful Relationships Learning in Foundation

In Foundation, students will be learning strategies to help them to solve problems. They will brainstorm possible choices and decide if those choices have positive or negative consequences. By listening to a story, they will consider the feelings of a character and consider when it is a good time for the character to ask for help. They will then role play asking for help themselves and brainstorm options the character can take to solve his problem. By doing so, students will learn that there are many options when it comes to solving a problem. Finally, students will reflect on times when they may need to use problem solving strategies.

Student Learning Conferences

The school will be hosting Student Learning Conferences, on Tuesday the 18th and Wednesday the 19th of June from 3:30pm to 5:30pm. The focus of the Student Learning Conferences will be to discuss your child's progress with their teacher, as well as providing an opportunity for your child to discuss their successes with you. The Student Learning Conferences will take place in your child's classroom. Ten minutes is allocated for each Student Learning Conference.
